TERMS AND CONDITIONS

This licence is granted to the trade organisation under Section 3 of the Trade Organisations Ordinance, 2007 and is subject to provisions of Trade Organisations Ordinance 2007, Trade Organisations Rules, 2007, the government laws, rules, regulations and instructions issued by the Federal Government and Director-General from time to time.

This licence is further subject to the following terms and conditions:

- (i) The trade organisation shall henceforth be governed under the new Memorandum and Articles of Association as authenticated by the Federal Government and Securities and Exchange Commission of Pakistan within such time as notified in this behalf. Upon authentication of the new Memorandum and Articles of Association by the Federal Government and SECP, the existing memorandum shall become inoperative and of no legal consequence.
- (ii) The trade organisation shall always be in possession of a valid National Tax Number and filing statutory income tax returns, if applicable.

Any change in the rules, procedures and laws subsequently promulgated by the Federal Government in relation to trade organisations shall be deemed to be a condition attached to this licence.

Without prejudice to the provisions of Section 7 of the Trade Organisations Ordinance, the violation of any of the terms and conditions of the licence shall make the licence liable to cancellation by the Federal Government.
